

Recap February 2026

We had 34 members present for our general meeting held on Monday, February 9, 2026. Quorum requirements were met.

A new budget for the year was presented to the club. The board decided that we would pare back expenses since we spent a lot of our reserve for the new machines we purchased last year. We don't want our reserves to go below \$ 5000 as it changes some of the parameters of the club. After some discussion, the motion was voted on and carried. Cyndi Strohmier led a focus group that proposed a new location for the library. It will be located in the northwest corner of the room and cut down by about a third. This measure is designed to give more access and better lighting to the library. It also cuts down on the use of ladders in the room, which is a safety issue. That measure was also voted on and carried.

Our new President, Karen Lee, commented on the non-stop helpfulness of our community of quilters that have been helping some of our members who have been struggling a little getting used to our new machines. She also read a thank you note from the dance company for allowing them to use our room for changing their costumes during their performances. Along with the note was a 50\$ gift card for the club.

Secretary Linda Pendleton asked us to read and accept the minutes provided for the January meeting. Voted and carried. She also announced the sewing table sale drawing and collected the money for the entries for those who were interested. It was a really good deal for \$50.00. Joan Ladley bought the table .It was just taking up room in the quilt room. Linda also announced that we would be doing a 50/50 drawing each meeting. The tickets are 1\$ and 6 for 5\$. The proceeds will be split by the ticket drawn and the club. This month we collected \$126.00. Char Counts

won and got \$63 and the club got \$63. Each quarter we will raffle off an item donated to the club as well.

It was also announced that we would not be making a raffle quilt for next year. This will be the last year of selling tickets. The tickets for the current year's quilt will be available at the March meeting. We will have a table at the craft fair this year for the drawing.
